<p>Luxulyan Woods Meet Boscastle Car Park 10.30am or Blackhill Car Park PI24 2RZ aprox 11.15am 3-4 mls Moderate circular Bring pack lunch Walk starts at the Black Hill Luxulyan Valley car park and climbs up to Trefry Viaduct. Route follows track of horse drawn tramway to the wheelpit where a 30ft waterwheel once hauled wagons up the steep slope, then follow the leat that powered the waterwheels of the Fowey Consols Mine back via Carmears wood along the river.</p> <p>Valency Valley & Minster Church 2.00pm Meet at Boscastle NT Café 2-3 mls 2 hrs Easy Explore Valency Valley, cross the footbridge to Peter's wood then up to Minster Church, back via Old road.</p>	<p>Pentire & The Rumps 11am NT Pentire Farm Car Park, Polzeath. 3-4 mls Moderate 10.15am Meet at Boscastle car park to car share Pentire Farm, then Pengirt Cove, Com Head, and on to the Rumps, Pentire Point, Pentireglaze Haven and a stop in New Polzeath before returning to the car park at the farm.</p> <p>Crooklets to Sandymouth 2½ hrs Moderate/Easy Meet 1.30pm Boscastle car park to car share or 2pm at Crooklets car park Bude North from Crooklets beach taking in history of the area, including the arrival of the railway to Bude and the use of the area for training prior to D-Day. Return along inland route.</p>	<p>'Exploring wild cliffs, wildlife & wild people' Boscastle to Tintagel Castle Meet: 10.30am at the National Trust café, Boscastle. 2-2½ hour, 5 mile moderate walk with some short hills. Bring lunch or buy in Tintagel. Then either walk back (1.30 - 3.30pm) or take the bus back to Boscastle.</p> <p>St Breward to Lank One section towards the end of the walk is a little strenuous. 3 miles Meet: 1pm Boscastle car park to car share or 1.45pm at War Memorial St Breward. Circular walk from St Breward opp Church to Tuckingmill, through Lamphills Woods to Coombe Mill through fields to river Camel, then on to Higher Lank. Back to St Breward via Tor Down Granite Quarry.</p>	<p>Pentargon & back via Valency Valley 3-4 hrs Strenuous in places Meet: 9.30am Boscastle NT Café Circular walk from Café along coast path past Pentargon falls and back via Valency Valley.</p> <p>Tintagel church to Trebarwith Circular 2-3 hrs Easy/moderate meet: Tintagel church car park 2pm Circular walk to Trebarwith Strand and back. Local history of the area including the many slate quarries along the coast.</p>	<p>"Walk on the wild side on Bodmin Moor". circular 6 miles 3-4 hrs Strenuous Meet 10.00am at Boscastle car park to car share or Rough Tor car park 10.45am Bring pack lunch and waterproofs etc. Walk from Rough Tor car park via Louden Hill to King Arthur's Hall then Alex Tor to Stannon Moor and back to the car park.</p> <p>Hardy & Wellington Meet 2pm Wellington Hotel car park to car share to St Juliot church. Easy Walk back from the church through the Valency valley. A literary walk with Hardy's poetry and prose read in the locations he wrote about.</p>	<p>Port Quin, Port Isaac & Port Gaverne.Circular Meet 10.15am Boscastle car park to car share or 11am Port Quin car park. 8 miles some strenuous. Bring packed lunch. Coast to Kelkan Head, Reedy Cliff, Varley Head, Lobber Point & then Port Isaac (for lunch), Port Gaverne and return via inland route catching views of Pine Haven before passing Roscarrock & strolling down to PQ. Those with the energy might want to have a peek at Doyden Castle.
