The route descends into the wooded valley along the De Lank river, crossing the river to the Delank granite quarries. The walk skirts the edge of the quarry pit, before crossing the Pendrift Downs to Jubilee Rock. The walk then returns via lanes and fields to the Blisland village green with its Inn and impressively ornate church.</p>
